Solid Wind Power Enters the Japanese Wind Turbine Market

Skjern, Denmark, July 7, 2017: Solid Wind Power A/S, a rapidly growing technology company, has become ready to install their wind turbines in Japan by their recent acquisition of Class NK certificate.

With their full certification – by ClassNK (Japanese authorized certification for small wind turbines by Nippon Kaiji Kyokai), the Solid Wind 19.8kW turbines are qualified for a Japanese national incentive program (FIT, Feed-in-tariff). The FIT program has helped spur a boom in solar installations in Japan. The FIT certification program for small wind turbines will have the same impact on the small wind market.

“We are proud that our 19.8kW turbines – which are advanced design of our best-selling turbines in Denmark and Europe in the 19.8kW – 25kW range – are now in Japan with Class NK certified,” explained Carsten Lauridsen, CEO and owner of Solid Group. “We have installed more than 500 turbines in Denmark and now we are excited to expand our business in Japan to use Japanese FIT program. We are well positioned to capitalize on the expected growth in the Japanese market. In fact, our Japanese distribution partners are already seeing a dramatic increase in orders and expect to begin shipping a large number of units to Japan.”

Solid Wind Power 19.8kW turbines have unique design and features: High performance blade, efficient power generator, low-noise gear box, anti-vibration damper, sophisticated yaw control system, multi-braking system, remote SCADA system, and easier maintenance system.

Japan is one of the few markets that offer higher incentives for small wind compared to solar.
